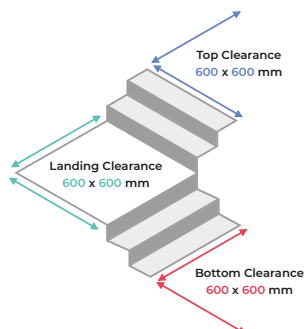

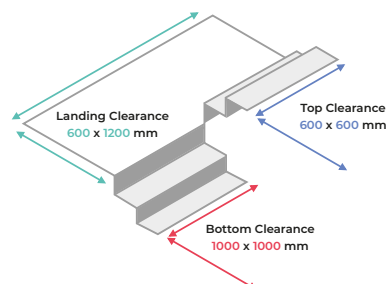
Minimum: 600 x 600 mm

The diagrams below shows the typical minimum clearances required on stairways. Actual requirements may vary depending on your stairway configuration.

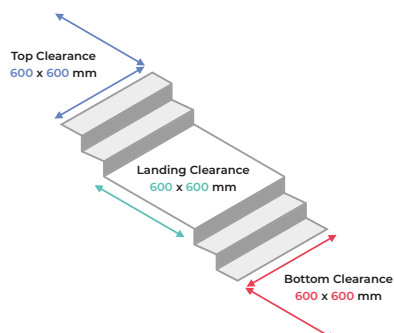
L-shaped Landing



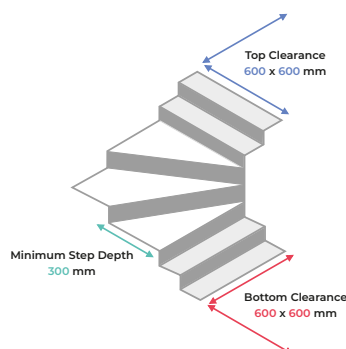
U-shaped Landing



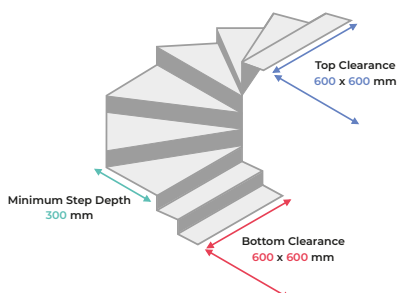
Straight with Landing
